TellicoLife Strategy and Focus for 2023

- Strategy
 - TellicoLife features to be included in requirements for new POA system(s). Beth Kuberka is leading this effort.
- Tactical Focus for 2023
 - Make Calendar available to more clubs
- Gather updated requirements in order to meet with Personify and evaluate other vendors
 - Larry McJunkin has the lead
- Goals for 2023

Larry has just started to look at requirements. Needs the Platinum club representatives to look at the requirements before finalizing the requirements.

We will also be looking at other vendors, but most other vendors only handle 1 club; not multiple clubs. We need meet with Personify.

We should be prepared to pay more.

Larry will go ahead with these plans for initial meeting and on-line collaboration.

TellicoLife Calendar Expansion Proposal

Goal: Expand calendar access to more clubs and organizations

Proposal: Redefine the levels of participation

- Add four 'free' calendar entries to clubs and orgs listed in Tlife ['Village Organization Directory'](#).
- Blue – logo on home page and four calendar entries. \$30/year
- Silver – collapse Silver and Bronze. Logo, TellicoLife page and 24 calendar entries. \$60/year
- Gold – unlimited calendar entries and pages. \$300/year
- Platinum – unchanged features
 - Propose upgrading New Villagers to sponsor level at \$1800/year

TO DO: KC will redo the chart based on not collapsing Silver and Bronze this year and waiting until next year, adding NV at \$1,000.

TellicoLife Calendar Expansion Proposal – To Do's

Reach agreement on proposal

If approved:

- Define process for updating [Clubs and Organizations](#) List
- Define process and workflow for adding calendar entries and updating content for the Gold, Silver and Blue clubs.
- Update documentation
- Update TellicoLife organization for Bronze clubs (move to silver)
- Update TellicoLife subscription form for 2023
- Submit subscription forms and generate invoices
- ???

New Villagers is the biggest user of TellicoLife. Concerned about the 3x increase. NV would like to get the data behind the increase. That way he can take it to the NV board.

Discussion ensued about inflation increase, increases over time, and encouraging all clubs to join.

There hasn't been a rate increase in 5 years. Mission states "one place for all events". Platinum clubs would be supporting the other clubs.

Ken reminded us that our goal is to have 1 place where people can see the events for all clubs.

Discussion on process changes that need for free clubs

Discussion on what clubs can participate. KC showed the Village Directory.

TO DO: Beth, KC, Ginger need to set up process to handle free clubs vs. subscription clubs for calendar entries.

To Do: Increase Blue to 6.

Decision: Hold off on the collapse of Silver and Bronze until next year. Go ahead and send at invoices at same rate

This will also show us how many clubs decide to go to free and not pay a subscription.

Votes:

Motion #1: New Villagers subscription shall increase to \$1,000

– Motion Larry, 2nd Beth, Bob Wolf – Abstained, All others Approve – Motion carries

Motion 2: Move forward to expand calendar entries to the clubs in the organization directory. They would get 4 calendar entries.

- Motion Bruce, Ken 2nd, All in favor. Motion carried.

TO DO: Larry will put into the requirements a request to add a privacy check box on Personify login. That way we don't have to send out forms in the future.

New Action Items

- Larry - put "Help Wanted" in next issue of TVUC newsletter.
- Larry – Set up meeting with the Platinum Clubs to review the collection of requirements and start process of prioritization.
- KC -- update the Proposal Financials based on not collapsing Silver and Bronze this year and waiting until next year, adding NV at \$1,000.
- Beth, KC, Ginger -- set up process to handle free clubs vs. subscription clubs for calendar entries.
- KC --Increase Blue to 6, change documents
- KC – Provide Bob with data he can take to NV board
- Bob – Bob Wolf to take increase proposal to NV Board on 12/15 and then report back after their meeting
- KC, Ginger – Send out Invoices to all clubs at current rate with one exception. Hold NV invoice until approval is attained.
