SEWING : DECORATIVE PILLOW COVERS (FRENCH SEAMS) Online Workshop Friday, February 12th, 2021 @ 9:00am \$25 per person

HOA has partnered up with the <u>Knoxville Fine Arts and Craft Center</u> (KAFCC) to offering a wonderful assortment of classes in various mediums for you to learn or expand your skill. These are fun activities you can complete from your own home.

Show off your new sewing skills at home with your very own handmade pillow cover! Emily will teach you the basics of machine-stitching and guide you to make an envelope-style decorative pillow cover with French seams to fit a 20" x 20" insert. We will provide you with pre-cut plain 100% cotton fabric with matching thread and written instructions to refer to later. You will also need a sewing machine, fabric scissors, an iron, a ruler/tape measure, and straight pins. Some sewing experience recommended, but not essential.

The cost of this class includes enough material to make two pillow covers. <u>Include your choice of color at registration</u>. Students will need to have access to a computer and a sewing machine.

- 2) Once signed up (registered) please email Sheryl Warmbold (<u>swarmbold@gmail.com</u>) to let her know you have paid your registration.
- 3) IMPORTANT: If we get at least three (3) individuals signed up for the class and Sheryl is notified 4 days prior to the class:
 - a. then Sheryl, as your HOA Event Coordinator (EC) will be doing the following for you:
 - picking up the necessary tools, materials, etc. from the KAFCC for each class participant. Class participants will need to pick up at the EC's home prior to the class starting – the day before the class starts. Likely the EC would leave the materials on their porch and you could pick at your leisure the day before <u>the event</u>.
 - ii. Depending upon what is being made in each class, the Event Coordinator (EC) will be:
 - 1. Returning any tools supplied by KAFCC. You will need to drop off to the EC's home after the class.
 - 2. taking back (if needed) semi-finished projects for firing at KAFCC. You will need to drop off to the EC's home after the class.
 - 3. picking up the finished projects for pickup by class participants. EC will notify you when ready for pickup.
- 4) If we don't get three individuals signed up for the class, Sheryl will email you and you'll have to either 1) pick up and return your materials yourself, 2) make arrangements with the other participants, or 3) drop the class (24 hours cancelation window before the class with KAFCC).

- 6) So right before the class starts, please make sure you have all materials on hand and then simply sign in using the YouTube link.
