Plants are not growing outside at this time but you can grow things inside! Chia heads are a fun way to do just that! Emily will show participants how to pinch a base for the head and then add facial features to create your very own Chia Head!

KAFCC will supply the material for the CHIA, once made KAFCC will fire these in their kiln, and then provide potting soil and chia seeds and instructions on how to plant them...then you can watch them grow! Students will need to have access to a computer and be willing to have fun!

- 2) Once signed up (registered) please email Sheryl Warmbold (<u>swarmbold@gmail.com</u>) to let her know you have paid your registration.
- 3) IMPORTANT: If we get at least three (3) individuals signed up for the class and Sheryl is notified 4 days prior to the class:
 - a. then Sheryl, as your HOA Event Coordinator (EC) will be doing the following for you:
 - i. picking up the necessary tools, materials, etc. from the KAFCC for each class participant. Class participants will need to pick up at the EC's home prior to the class starting – the day before the class starts. Likely the EC would leave the materials on their porch and you could pick at your leisure the day before <u>the event</u>.
 - ii. Depending upon what is being made in each class, the Event Coordinator (EC) will be:
 - 1. Returning any tools supplied by KAFCC. You will need to drop off to the EC's home after the class.
 - 2. taking back (if needed) semi-finished projects for firing at KAFCC. You will need to drop off to the EC's home after the class.
 - 3. picking up the finished projects for pickup by class participants. EC will notify you when ready for pickup.
- 4) If we don't get three individuals signed up for the class, Sheryl will email you and you'll have to either 1) pick up and return your materials yourself, 2) make arrangements with the other participants, or 3) drop the class (24 hours cancelation window before the class with KAFCC).
