Depart Tellico Village by car at 10am on March 1<sup>st</sup> for Nashville. Check into the Comfort Suites in Mt Juliet TN then head downtown for an afternoon of great music and eats on Nashville's Broadway!! You will have 7:30 PM tickets for the Cinch World's Toughest Rodeo at the Bridgestone Arena which includes bareback riding, saddle bronco riding, barrel racing and the amazing bull riders. Featuring a "Main Event" Showdown Round with head to head match up of the top two in each event. The ultimate fan experience!!!

Overnight at the Comfort Suites in Mt Juliet which includes a complimentary breakfast the next morning.

After breakfast drive to Belle Meade Plantation for a tour of one of the largest and most historic mansions in Nashville. The 1800s mansion was the home of the Harding family and the center of horse racing and social events for the horse racing industry at that time. The tour will share the history of the plantation and the Harding family whose horses created the bloodlines of many future horse racing champions. The plantation still contains most of the original furnishings of the Harding family. Your tour will conclude with complimentary wine tasting from the Belle Meade wine collection. Belle Meade has a well-stocked gift shop with unique items and is definitely not the traditional souvenir shop!! Lunch can be purchased in the Belle Meade restaurant before you begin your drive back to Tellico.
