Quebec City - Get a taste of France without crossing the Atlantic! Have a cocktail at the famous Hotel Frontenac, visit the plaza Place Royale & see La Citadelle, a star-shaped fortress & active military garrison.

Charlottetown, PEI - This area is the “Birthplace of New Scotland” where Scottish Highlanders landed in 1773 and Scottish traditions and Gaelic folklore come alive. Visit Glenora Distillery, first in North America.

Sydney, Nova Scotia - Founded by Loyalists fleeing the American Revolution, take a walking tour to see historic sites including St. Patrick’s, oldest Catholic church in Cape Breton & Cape Breton Ctr. For Heritage & Science. Hit the high seas for a whale-watching tour - it’s the right season!

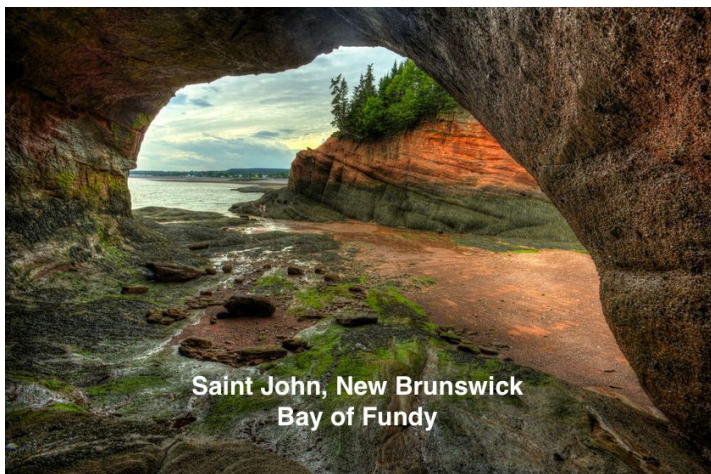
Halifax, Nova Scotia - In this capital city, visit Pier 21 or the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, housing a vast collection of Titanic memorabilia. See Lunenburg, a restored historic village & UNESCO site. Eat “fresh off the boat” lobster!

Saint John, New Brunswick - Located on the north shore of the Bay of Fundy. Watch how the highest tidal range in the world causes a river to reverse direction! See it up close by taking jet boat through Reversing Falls rapids.

Portland, Maine - Small, sophisticated coastal city, Portland has become a port of call for many cruise ships. As New England’s cultural hub, the city is a showcase for artists, musicians, craftsmen & actors.


Bar Harbor, Maine - Acadia National Park, a 47,000-acre mix of rocky shores, towering cliffs & forested mountains. Take a carriage ride on any of the 45 miles of roads in the first national park east of the Mississippi.

Boston, Mass - History comes to life in this city, rich in museums, galleries, parks & historic sites. Follow Freedom Trail - Paul Revere’s route - or see restored tea ships at Boston Tea Party Ships & Museum. Visit Concord Bridge, where “Minutemen” fired the “shot heard ‘round the world!” Walk Newbury St, home to boutique shops & cafes.
