

Listed by the Guinness Book of World Records as America's largest underground lake, the Lost Sea is part of an extensive and historic cave system called Craighead Caverns. Visitors are treated, among many geological formations, to a variety of interesting formations called "anthodites." These fragile, spiky clusters commonly known as "cave flowers" are rarely seen and prompted the United States Department of the Interior to designate the Lost Sea as a Registered National Landmark. During your ascension towards the Lost Sea you will hear stories about the cave's earliest visitors from the Pleistocene period, the Cherokee Indians, Civil War soldiers and its 1905 re-discovery by a 13yr old.

Underground temps 58 degrees. Wear closed toe shoes.

This involves a ¾ mile round-trip walk on wide sloping pathways that can be very steep in places. You must be able to walk up the equivalent of 14 stories from the bottom as it's 140' below ground. This is not recommended for anyone with heart or breathing issues or persons in need of walking aids. Tour is not adapted for anyone handicapped. Wear shoes with good treads due to the sometimes slick and muddy nature of the under ground path.
