The Museum of Appalachia is a living history museum – a pioneer mountain farm village that lends voice to the people of Southern Appalachia through the artifacts & stories they left behind.

Set on 65 picturesque acres, with 35 log cabins, barns, churches, schools and farm animals, you can take your time and enjoy the experience. Three buildings contain 250,000 artifacts so you can get a good idea of their life.
