Join fellow new villagers for a fun day of exploring and hiking at the Ijams Nature Center near Knoxville.

We will begin at the Nature Center Visitors Center for a restroom stop and overview of the park. We will then proceed to the Mead's Quarry Lake parking lot to begin our hike on the Flow Trail. We will hike through the abandoned Marble Quarry areas, before returning via the Imerys Trail. This loop trail combination will result in a total hiking distance of approximately 2.3 miles. These trails are generally easy, but will include some elevation gain (total of 167 feet) and rocky terrain. Please wear appropriate hiking shoes/boots, walking sticks are also recommended.

Afterwards, we will proceed to the nearby SoKno Taco Cantina on Sevierville Pike. This casual eating establishment features varied Mexican entrees with both indoor and outdoor dining areas. Following lunch, all will return home on their own.
