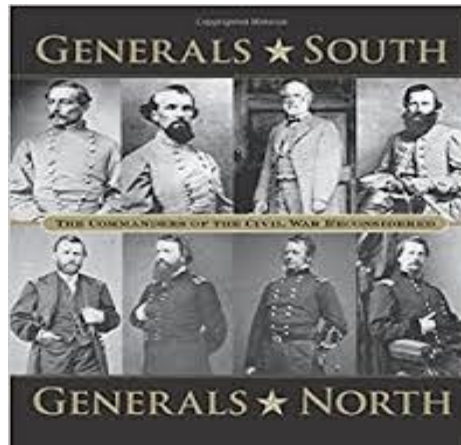




Civil War Lecture #2 (\$5)

TOPIC: Civil War Generals: The Good, the Bad and the Political.

The Civil War produced hundreds of generals on both sides of the conflict. Some of them never lost a battle, some of them never won a battle and still others rose to that elevated rank because of their political connections which often led to unpredictable results on the battlefield. We will look at several generals in each category and assess their performances and legacies.

SPEAKER: Tim Vane – Tim served in the US Army for more than 20 years and retired as a Lieutenant Colonel. During his time on active duty he participated in Operation Just Cause (Panama), the first Gulf War and Operation Uphold Democracy (Haiti). He earned his BA from La Salle University and MA from California State University. His military education includes the Field Artillery Basic and Cannon Courses, the Infantry Officer Advanced Course, the Defense Information School and the Command and General Staff School. Tim Vane retired from ORNL in 2014; he now owns his own consulting company and is co-owner of How2LeadUS which teaches leadership development to businesses and organizations. The company uses Civil War battlefields as the classroom and often uses re-enactors and equipment as part of the instruction.
