The Museum of Appalachia is a living history museum – a pioneer mountain farm village that lends voice to the people of Southern Appalachia through the artifacts & stories they left behind. They are an amazing and resourceful people.

Set on 65 picturesque acres, with 35 log cabins, barns, churches, schools and farm animals, you can take your time and enjoy the experience. Three buildings contain 250,000 artifacts to give you a good idea of their life and the grounds are amazing!

Lunch (on your own) is served daily from 11-2 and specializes in Southern Appalachian country cooking. Sandwiches and drinks are also available from 2-3. Be sure to check out their incredible gift and craft shop!

The Museum is open 9am til 6pm. Admission is \$17 per person (maximum of 50 people). About an hour drive from Tellico Village, we plan to meet at the Museum at 11, but you can arrive when it's convenient for you & your schedule and stay as long as you like; 3-4 hours seems a good amount of time to experience it all. We will distribute armbands prior to the date.
