After the paddle, we may enjoy the nice outdoor deck at the marina. The marina store sells snacks, drinks and draft beer. Please plan to bring your lunch if you want more than snacks or another option is to order pizza from Papa John's (865-717-1234) in Kingston and have it delivered to the marina.
