Thursday, June 3, 2021 Old James Ferry Boat Ramp, Kingston

Length: 5 Miles
Type: Out/Back
Rated: Easy

Beautiful paddle down Riley Creek approximately 5 miles round trip. Will launch at Old James Ferry boat launch in Kingston - cross the channel into Riley Creek. Easy paddle calm, protected water.

Plan to be in the water at the boat launch off Old James Ferry Road in Kingston by 9:30 a.m. on Thursday - June 3, 2021.

Directions are as follows:

Take Kingston Exit 352 off I-40 West and go right on N. Kentucky Street (South Hwy 58). Continue on N. Kentucky Street approximately 1.8 mi. You will see Fort Southwest Point parking lot on the right side of road and you will make a left hand turn on to James Ferry Rd. almost immediately after passing parking lot. Go approx. 0.8 of mile and turn right on Old James Ferry Rd. You will see sign for Calvary Hazelwood cemetery on right (100 ft) before turn. Old James Ferry rd. dead ends at boat launch (0.4 mi). If you come down hwy. 70 you will turn left on N. Kentucky St. (S. Hwy 58). Distance to turn on James Ferry Rd would be around half mile or so.
