

Kahite to Ball Play Paddle Thur. June 25th

This is a moderate 8 mile paddle. The paddle with start on 4 Mile Creek and proceed to the Tennessee River, first going around Kahite, and then into less traveled parts of the river. There should be some lovely views of the mountains as we paddle toward Ball Play we hope to see eagles, osprey, herons and other birds.

This is a shuttle paddle and this time we are asking each vehicle to come prepared with their own driver to return their vehicle to the exit point at Ball Play Boat Ramp. Shuttle drivers will leave their cars at Sloans. We will provide one or two drivers to return the shuttle drivers to Sloans in Tellico Village. Directions and maps will be provided. Be sure to bring an extra key for your car as the shuttle driver will lock one set in the car at Ball Play.

Gear needed: kayak, canoe or paddle board, PFD, paddle, water, snack, sunblock, sponge or pump, rope,
