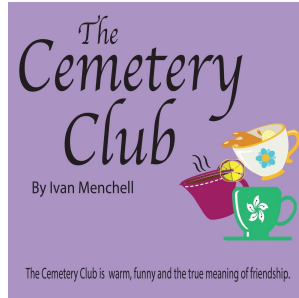




TELLICO COMMUNITY PLAYERS

Attendance at only one audition date is required; you will audition in order of arrival. All characters (4 women, 1 man) are in their late fifties to early sixties - descriptions are available on the audition form on our website.

The Cemetery Club is a funny and poignant look at grief and getting on with life. Three Jewish widows meet monthly for tea before visiting their husbands' graves. Ida is sweet tempered and ready to begin a new life; Lucille is the embodiment of the girl who just wants to have fun; and Doris is priggish and judgmental, particularly when Sam the butcher enters the scene. Lucille and Doris don't support Ida's romance with Sam, complicating things a bit.
