Sam Henderson: male, 30+ years old, Susy's husband, nice guy (45 lines)

Mike: male, 30-40 years old, sly, crafty (175 lines)

Carlino: male, 30-40 years old, ex-cop (130 lines)

Roat: male, 30-40 years old, not a nice guy (240 lines)

Gloria: female, 13 years old (70 lines)

Three times per week, more or less as needed. Exact dates and times will be announced after the cast has been selected.
