LOOKOUT MOUNTAIN BLUFF TRAIL – Chattanooga

Friday October 14, 2022

Depart at 8AM from Lakeside Realty Parking Lot

This is an out and back hike from Point Park along the Bluff Trail into Georgia, we will turn around at an overlook just prior to Ochs Gateway. The trail runs along the cliffs of Lookout Mountain with a few tiny stream crossings. In a few sections it runs along some cliff edges but is not dangerous. There are several nice views and interesting rock formations with small caves.

There is some **free parking behind the ranger station**, immediate left after you drive up to the big gateway into the park. Otherwise you have to pay to park on the street. Point Park is a National Military Park; Admission is free for veterans and anyone who has a National Park pass or federal interagency land pass can get into the park for free and bring 3 people with them, otherwise there is a \$10 entrance fee. So please remember to **bring your NP Pass** if you have one and using that you can get 3 others in that don't have a pass.



Hiking boots and hiking sticks are recommended.



Driving directions will be provided the morning of the hike.



Bring water and a trail lunch.



Passengers are asked to contribute \$6 to the driver to help cover gas, etc.
