This is an out and back hike located in the Cumberland Trail State Park. The trail follows Newby Branch. Then continues to follow Duskin Creek where Newby Branch connects to Duskin Creek. The trail ends shortly after Duskin Creek connects to Piney River. White Pine Cascades, Deep Pool Cascades and Hemlock falls are located on this trail.



Hiking boots and hiking sticks are recommended.

Driving directions will be provided the morning of the hike. Bring water and a trail snack.

Passengers are asked to contribute \$6 to the driver to help cover gas, etc.
