Chestnut Top/Smoky Mountain National Park Friday, December 4, 2020

Depart at 8AM from Lakeside Realty Parking Lot

This is an in and out hike with the starting point and terminus at the Townsend "Y". Most of the elevation gain occurs in the first third of the hike. The trail follows a ridge crest for most of the distance, skirting the southeast side of Tuckaleechee Cove. Weather permitting there are some nice views of that cove and to the south is the Smokies crest, most notably Thunderhead Mountain.
