

Hike the East Lakeshore Trail Tuesday, September 19th

Join WATeR (The Watershed Association of the Tellico Reservoir) Tuesday, September 19th when we will hike a portion of the Sinking Creek Branch of the East Lakeshore Trail. This is rated as an easy trail but has some short elevation changes and tree roots. We will gather at the Poplar Springs Boat Ramp parking lot at 9:00 AM and carpool to the trailhead. Hikers from Kahite can meet us at the Coytee Trailhead on Coytee Rd near the large Cuthbertson-Martin (TVA) Bridge at 9:15 AM. The East Lakeshore Trails are just across the lake and are some of the most beautiful and accessible hiking trails in East Tennessee and have been designated as National Recreation Trails by the Department of the Interior. If you would like to become more familiar with these trails and/or would just like to take a short 2-3 mile hike, then come join us on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of every month.
